
# **GRACE AND HOLY TRINITY EPISCOPAL CATHEDRAL** A Servant Church in the Heart of the City

	the altar with one hundred twenty priests who were trumpeters). It was the duty of the trumpeters and
	singers to make themselves heard in unison in praise and thanksgiving to the Lord, and when the song
