[JOB DESCRIPTION]

The Associate Priest at Grace and Holy Trinity Cathedral is a full-time, senior staff position, working in consultation with the Dean to provide leadership for the spiritual welfare, pastoral care, Christian formation, and new member incorporation of the Cathedral. The Associate Priest reports to the Dean.

- Provides for and oversees pastoral care for parishioners, including homebound and hospitalized members.
- Provides leadership and support to our Pastoral Care Ministries, including Stephen Ministry, Visitation, Eucharistic Visitors, and Healing Ministries.
- Oversees Christian Formation program for children and youth, working in collaboration with the Children's Ministry Coordinator, Youth Director, volunteers, and Nursery Coordinator to ensure that children and families are integrated into all aspects of the community's life.
- Oversees new member incorporation into the life of the Cathedral community.
- Implements diocesan standards regarding *Safeguarding God's Children* and background checks for volunteers.
- Shares in all sacramental rites of the church.

- Pastoral sensitivity and ability to be present with people on their journeys.
- Growing in faith, with a healthy prayer life and an eagerness to explore Christ's call to mission and service.
